The Partnership

The Tonbridge and Malling District Cricket Partnership (T&MDCP) is made up of representatives from Kent Community Cricket, Tonbridge & Malling Borough Council, local cricket clubs, sports colleges and sponsors.

The aim of the partnership is to promote the sport of cricket in Tonbridge and Malling to anyone that wants to play, coach, officiate or watch the game.

Indoor Coaching Programme

All the coaching is run at indoor facilities with cricket nets. The coaches are all qualified, experienced and checked by the Disclosure and Barring Service (formerly CRB).

The courses are graded by age, but hard ball cricket is not introduced until a player is deemed confident and competent enough.

Cricket whites are not compulsory but players are welcome to wear them if they wish. We do ask however, for players not to wear black soled plimsolls or trainers as they mark the floor.

Please note all the courses run for 10 weeks without a break for October or February half-terms

Young Leaders in Cricket Award

The Young Leaders in Cricket Award is a community based sports leadership course, approved by the England and Wales Cricket Board and Kent Cricket Board.

The aim of the course is to give young people in Years 9 & 10 (14 - 16 years) the skills to develop their competency in cricket leadership, scoring and umpiring, groundsmanship and first aid.

The course runs between April and July and consists of 15 hours of taught modules and 20 hours volunteering. This culminates in a presentation at Lords Cricket Ground in October.
