

THE TONBRIDGE AND MALLING BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021
Amendment 1 – Tonbridge residents' season tickets

Statement of Reasons

In the Borough of Tonbridge & Malling

The Borough Council has had requests to address parking concerns from residents of Tonbridge town centre that have no access to private parking facilities or existing on-street resident permit schemes due to their location. Unfortunately, it is not possible to provide on-street residents parking bays in the town centre due to the road widths and the levels of development.

Accordingly, the Council is proposing a new Tonbridge town centre residents' car parking season ticket, which would allow residents with no alternative to park in the long-stay car parks nearby.

Initially this is being offered as for a trial period to people who reside in properties in Tonbridge town centre in the area between the High Street (to the west), the railway (to the south and east) and the river Medway (to the north), who are not already eligible for parking permits as part of an on-street residents parking scheme.
