Statement of Reasons

In the Parish of Aylesford

Location	Proposals	Reasons
Sycamore Drive	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking on the bend and near driveways. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.

In the Parish of Aylesford (Eccles)

Location	Proposals	Reasons
Bull Lane & Greenfield Close	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.

In the Parish of Aylesford (Walderslade)

Location	Proposals	Reasons
Woodbury Road & Walsham Road	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.
Woodbury Road	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.

In the Parish of Borough Green

Location	Proposals	Reasons
Quarry Hill Road & Dark Hill road roundabout	New double yellow lines	There have been reports of problems with parking on the roundabout. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.

In the Parish of East Malling & Larkfield

Location	Proposals	Reasons
A20 London Road & Walnut Tree Court (East Malling)	Changing single yellow line to double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.
Lavender Close, Lavender Road and Carnation Crescent (East Malling)	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Lavender Road and Lilac Green (East Malling)	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Mill Street & Middle Mill Road (East Malling)	New permit parking bays	Residents have reported problems with non-resident parking. The extension of the neighbouring resident permit parking scheme should give more facility for residents.
Lunsford Lane (Larkfield)	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Lunsford Lane (near Leybourne Lakes) (Larkfield)	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Maple Close & Oak Drive (Larkfield)	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.

In the Parish of Leybourne

Location	Proposals	Reasons
The Croft	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.

In the Town of Tonbridge

Location	Proposals	Reasons
Ashburnham Road	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.

Chiltern Way & Cheviot Close	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Dodd Road & Romney Way	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.
Priory Road	New Bus Stop Clearway or Bus Stand	The proposals allow facilities for buses to operate a more effective service.
St Marys Road	Changes to parking bay times (additional 1 hour restriction in afternoons) and new double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with non-resident parking after the morning restriction ends. The proposal to introduce a further 1 hour restriction to the afternoons should prevent this. There have also been access problems for refuse collection vehicles and for residents using driveways and the proposals also include changes to parking bays and new double yellow lines to help maintain access.
The Haydens	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with obstructive parking. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this.
Woodgate Way	New double yellow lines	Concerns have been raised that parking on Woodgate impedes traffic movements and should not occur alongside the existing double white line system that prevents overtaking. The proposals should remove parking at this location and improve traffic movements.

In the Parish of Wrotham

Location	Proposals	Reasons
A20 London Road (near Tower Industrial Estate)	Removal of parking bays and new double yellow lines	There have been reports of problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.
Pilgrims Way	New double yellow lines	Residents have reported problems with parking close to the junction. The double yellow lines are intended to prevent this, in line with the requirements of the Highway Code.
