

Notice under s.2(9) of Schedule 4 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (the “Act”)

Take Notice that on 27th September 2022, following a period of public consultation, Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council passed a resolution under paragraph 2 (8) of Schedule 4 to the Act designating all of the streets in their borough as consent streets for the purposes of street trading.

This designation shall come into force on 1st April 2023.

A “Consent Street” is a street in which street trading is prohibited without the consent of the Council.

Only persons who have applied for and been granted a “street trading consent” by the Licensing Committee, Licensing Sub-Committee or by an Officer of the Council with delegated powers may lawfully engage in street trading once the designation has come into force. All other forms of street trading will be illegal and offenders may be prosecuted.
