Tonbridge & Malling Borough Council Election of a Borough Councillor for Snodland East & Ham Hill Ward

1. An election is to be held for a Borough Councillor for Snodland East & Ham Hill Ward.
2. Nomination papers may be obtained by visiting the Electoral Commission Website.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer at the address shown below on any working day after the publication of this notice, Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm, but no later than 4pm on **Wednesday 2 April 2025**. **Appointments to deliver nominations can be made on the telephone number below.**
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 1 May 2025**, between the hours of 7am and 10pm.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on **Friday 11 April 2025**. Applications may be made on paper forms or online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on **Monday 14 April 2025**.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on **Wednesday 23 April 2025**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on **Thursday 1 May 2025**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on **Wednesday 23 April 2025**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on **Wednesday 23 April 2025**.
