ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections and 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 44, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ('the Act') the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposes to make the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on day of 2025 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tonbridge and Malling) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order (Amendment No.3) Order 2025" ('this Order')
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Tonbridge and Malling) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2025" ('the Order of 2025') shall have effect as though:

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Kent County Council as traffic authority intends to make the Order referred to above as shown on the drawing accompanying this document for the following reasons:-

a) Tonbridge - Cage Green Road

Extension to double yellow lines (no waiting at any time)

 Residents have requested that the existing double yellow lines around an access be extended to improve visibility for pedestrians and drivers. As detailed in Drawing DD613/1

b) Tonbridge – 176 Shipbourne Road

 A resident who has recently installed a new dropped kerb has requested new double yellow line protection across driveway to prevent obstruction. As detailed in Drawing DD613-6

c) Tonbridge – Tudeley Lane (Access to Rosewell House)

 Residents have requested double yellow lines on one side of the road to prevent obstructive parking on access road to residential care home. As detailed in Drawing DD613-4

d) Tonbridge - Norfolk Road

 Adjustment to the permit parking area to accommodate new enforceable disabled persons parking bay to provide more disabled parking facilities following a request from a resident with mobility issues. As detailed in Drawing DD613-3

e) Tonbridge - 45 Pembury Road

 A resident who has recently installed a new dropped kerb has requested new double yellow line protection across driveway to prevent obstruction. As detailed in Drawing DD613-5

f) Snodland - May Street

New double yellow lines (no waiting at any time)

 A resident who has recently installed a new dropped kerb has requested new double yellow line protection across their driveway to prevent obstruction. As detailed in Drawing DD613-7

g) East Malling – Carnation Crescent

New disabled persons parking bay

• A resident with mobility issues has requested a disabled persons parking bay to improve access and mobility. As detailed in Drawing DD613-2

The effect of the Order is

a) Tonbridge - Cage Green Road

Extension to existing double yellow lines to improve visibility.

b) Tonbridge - 176 Shipbourne Road

New dropped kerb requires double yellow lines to prevent obstruction.

c) Tonbridge - Tudeley Lane

Double yellow line protection on access to care home and along one side of the road

d) Tonbridge - Norfolk Road

Adjustment to permit parking bays to accommodate a new enforceable disabled person parking bay.

e) Tonbridge - 45 Pembury Road

Double yellow line protection across driveway to prevent obstruction of new driveway.

f) Snodland – May Street

Double yellow line protection across driveway to prevent obstruction of new driveway.

g) East Malling - Carnation Crescent

Change an existing advisory disabled persons parking bay opposite No 23 to an enforceable disabled persons parking bay.
