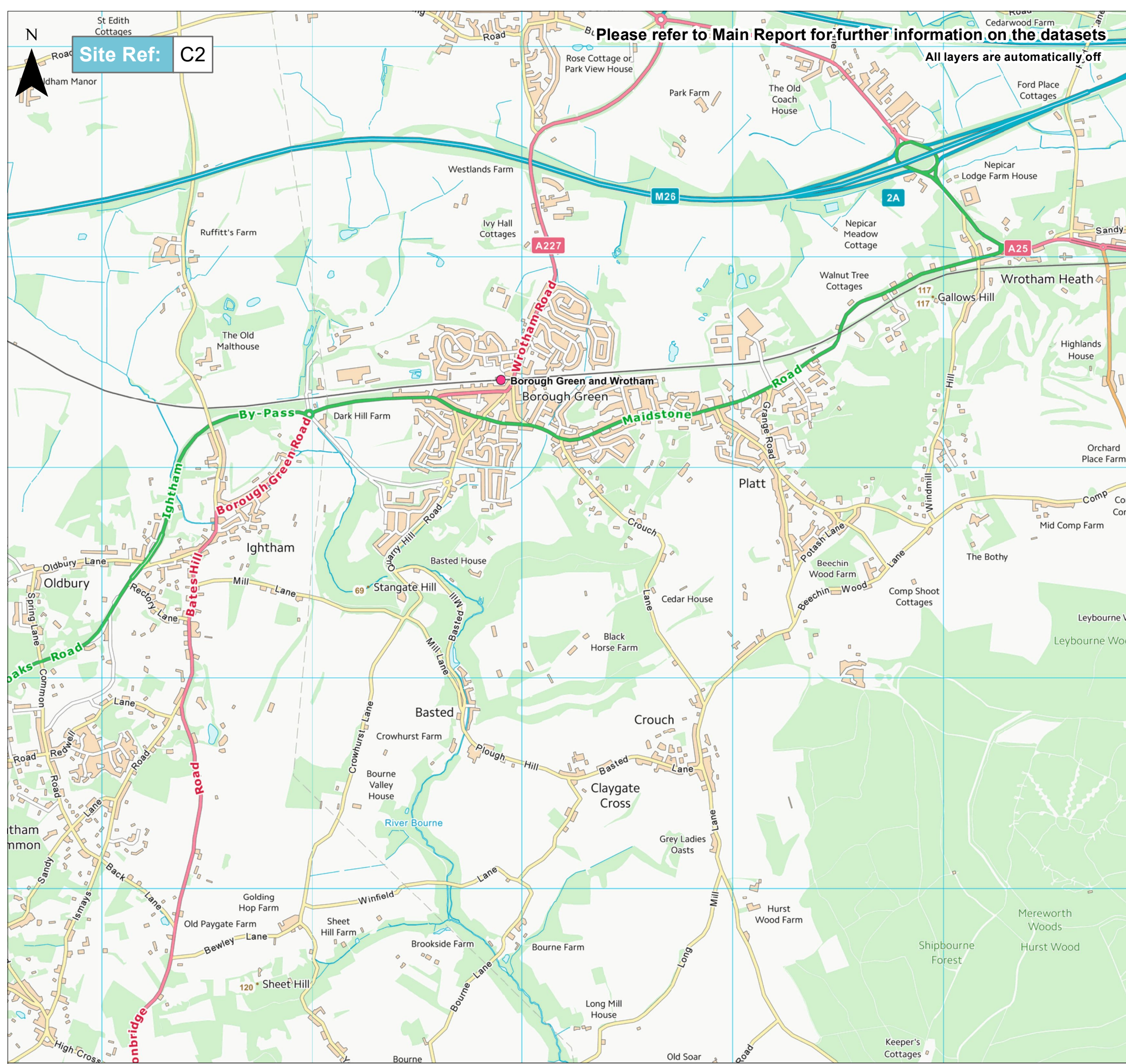
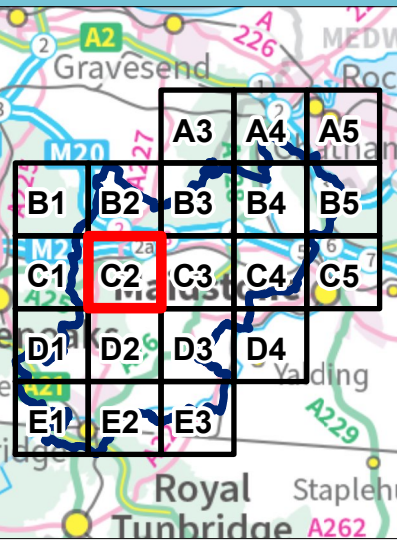




Tonbridge and Malling Level 1

  - Levels are at least 5m below the ground surface.
