
LAA Conclusion

This greenfield site on the southern periphery of Plaxtol, to the south of The Street. It is in use for agriculture and allotments. The retention/reprovision of the existing allotments should be taken into consideration.

The site is located wholly within the Green Belt and Kent Downs National Landscape, The Stage 2 Green Belt Assessment concludes that sub-area performs strongly against the NPPF purposes but makes a less important contribution to the wider Green Belt, and is recommended for further consideration. However, the landscape evidence concludes that there would likely be significant adverse landscape effects, even with mitigation, with no clear opportunities for a potential development to allow overall landscape enhancements to the National Landscape to be delivered.

Therefore, although the site is adjacent to a sustainable settlement, the landscape evidence concludes that this site is unsuitable for development.

The site is remote from any sustainable settlement and due to its unsustainable location is considered to be unsuitable for development.


