



STATEMENT OF REASONS



In the Borough of Tonbridge & Malling **THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL** **(VARIOUS ROADS, TONBRIDGE AND MALLING) (WAITING** **RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION)** **ORDER** **(AMENDMENT No.8) ORDER 2026**

The Kent County Council as traffic authority intends to make the Order referred to above as shown on the drawings accompanying this document for the following reasons :-

In the Parish of Aylesford

Hermitage Lane and A20 London Road

Following requests from members of the public and a bus company operating in the area, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines and bus stop clearways to prevent obstructive parking close to McDonalds and the approach to the traffic signals, and new bus stop clearway restrictions to maintain accessibility to bus stops for passenger service vehicles.

In the Parish of Aylesford (Walderslade)

Robin Hood Lane

Following requests from residents and the local Member, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking. New single yellow lines to prevent daytime parking, Monday to Friday 11am to Noon.

In the Parish of Borough Green

Wye Road

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking.

In the Parish of Ditton

Scott Close

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent parking around the junction near No's 32 & 41.

In the Parish of East Malling & Larkfield

Temple Way (East Malling)

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking.

The Rocks Road (East Malling)

Following requests from local Members, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking near Paris Farm Barn

Kingfisher Road (Larkfield)

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines between Magpie Close and Raven Close to prevent obstructive parking near junctions and to ease bus movements.

Lunsford Lane (Larkfield)

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking on Lunsford Lane and near the junction with Brook Road, and new bus stop clearway restrictions to maintain access to bus stops for public service vehicles.

In the Town of Snodland**Booth Close**

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking to maintain access for emergency vehicles

Brook Lane & Vauxhall Crescent

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking.

Charles Close

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking.

East Street & May Street

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking to maintain access for refuse freighters and emergency vehicles.

In the Town of Tonbridge**College Avenue and West Rise**

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking on the bend and junction.

Douglas Road

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstruction of the access to rear access road.

In the Parish of Wouldham**Worral Drive and Keepers Cottage Lane**

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking past the school, through the traffic calming and junctions and to prevent obstruction of the bus route. New bus stop clearway restrictions to maintain access to bus stops for public service vehicles.

In the Parish of Wrotham

Bancroft Road and West Street

Following requests from residents, the Council is proposing new double yellow lines to prevent parking around the junction.
