

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Election of a Town Councillor for Snodland West & Holborough Lakes ward of Snodland Town Council

1. An election is to be held for a Town Councillor for Snodland West & Holborough Lakes ward of Snodland Town Council.
2. Blank Nomination papers may be obtained, between the hours of 10am and 4pm, from the office of the Returning Officer at the address shown below. They can be requested by email or telephone call or downloaded from the Electoral Commission Website.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer at the address shown below on any working day between 10am and 4pm after the date of publication of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on **Friday 27 February 2026**. Please call to make an appointment on 01732 876354.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 26 March 2026**, between the hours of 7am and 10pm.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 10 March 2026**. Applications may be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote or request a paper form from the Elections team.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by **5pm on Wednesday 11 March 2026**. Applications to vote by post can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-postal-vote
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by **5pm on Wednesday 18 March 2026**. Applications to vote by proxy can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-proxy-vote
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 18 March 2026**. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by **5pm on Thursday 26 March 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5pm on Wednesday 18 March 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5pm on Wednesday 18 March 2026**.
